



When disaster calls – how will you respond?

The City of SeaTac, Burien & Kent RFA are offering the FEMA-sponsored **Community Emergency Response Team** training at *no charge* starting **April 16, 2015**.

Following a large scale emergency, professional responders may not be immediately available as they are tasked with multiple priorities. Through CERT training, individuals and organizations learn life-saving response skills to help each other until professionals arrive.

CERT includes 21 hours of training, plus a simulated disaster drill. Topics include the following:

- Hazard Identification & Disaster Preparedness
- Incident Command Systems and Team Organization
- Fire Safety and Suppression
- Light Search and Rescue
- Simple Triage
- Disaster Medical Operations
- Terrorism Awareness
- Disaster Psychology and Emotional Impacts
- Comprehensive Final Drill

Classes run each Thursday, 6:00 PM - 9:00 PM for seven weeks. The final drill and graduation are held on Saturday, May 30 from 9:00 AM - 1:00 PM. **Participants must attend all classes and the drill in order to receive a certificate of completion.**

The next CERT class starts on Thursday, April 16. Cost is FREE
