## WHAT IS IT?

Evidence-based programming that can help perpetrators:

- Be accountable for their actions
- Understand why they have acted violently
- Confront tendencies in current situations

*Domestic Violence Moral Reconciliation Therapy is a trademarked curriculum used by many states in conjunction with batterer treatment programming*

## WHO IS THIS FOR?

This course and its materials are tailored specifically for batterers, or the perpetrators of domestic violence.

## WHY SEND CLIENTS?

Group treatment often has better outcomes over individual treatment as group environments allow clients the ability to focus on and discuss shared problems.

## WHAT TO EXPECT?

- A weekly commitment for minimum of 6 months
- Cost: \$100
- 24 modules completed in a group session environment
- Homework and group participation required to advance to next module
- All sessions are open-ended, meaning new clients can enter the course at any time
