DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE
FILE SEP19-0002**

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSAL: SeaTac Shoreline Master Program (SMP) Periodic Review. This non-project proposal includes proposed amendments associated with the periodic review of the City's SMP. The periodic review is intended to keep the SMP current with amendments to state laws, changes to local plans and regulations, changes in local circumstances, and new or improved data or information. The proposed amendments can be summarized as follows: Updates exemptions from a Shoreline Substantial Development Permit to be consistent with those in state law. Adds exceptions, or developments not subject to City shoreline review, consistent with those in state law. Updates definitions to be consistent with those in state law. Revises headings for clarity. Updates obsolete or incorrect citations and references. Repeals Title 18 of the SeaTac Municipal Code and replaces it with the full Shoreline Master Program.

PROPONENT: City of SeaTac, Community and Economic Development

LOCATION: Property within 200 feet of the ordinary high water mark along Angle Lake

LEAD AGENCY: City of SeaTac

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment, and an environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c). This decision was made after review of a completed Environmental Checklist and other information on file with the lead agency.
