CALL TO ORDER: The Senior Citizen Advisory Committee meeting was called to order at 9:10 AM.

ADMINISTRATIVE STAFF: Linda Croasdill, Senior Services Supervisor and Amy Oliverson, Recreation Program Specialist

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Minutes dated February 19, 2019 were approved as written.

SEATAC CAFÉ UPDATE: We may want to purchase some dishes and similar supplies for Pasefika to use with the funds received from the grant for this partnership. Linda will talk with Mabel about what supplies they need and some possible changes to their schedule.

The St. Patrick's Day Luncheon was very successful. There were 164 paid attendees, which covered lunch costs with a surplus of about \$200. There will be no need to use advisory funds for this luncheon as originally planned.

MONEY MANAGEMENT UPDATE: The 2018 surplus funds from Advisory Committee fundraising will be deposited into the SeaTac Senior Program Fund at the Renton Community Foundation next week. The Mah Jongg cards Linda ordered should be delivered next week.

PURCHASES: No purchases to discuss at this time.

NEW BUSINESS: Charline Faulkner was introduced to the Committee. She has been selected as a new Senior Citizen Advisory Committee member and will be appointed at the City Council meeting on March 26, 2019. There is still one vacant position on the Committee.

Steve Pinto expressed concerns about trash and litter around the city.

Two new staff members have been hired for the Senior Program: Watson Tuiono started last week as the new Senior Center Attendant and Vitina Patterson starts today as the new Recreation Leader.

OLD BUSINESS: Linda provided an update on the King County VSHSL (Veteran's, Seniors & Human Services Levy) grant process. We are looking to partner with nearby communities to create a "hub" to provide more services that better meet our senior population's needs. Two major needs we have identified are an Outreach Coordinator and increased transportation options.

The new entrance doors are currently being installed and should be done by Thursday.
