A lot of students are undocumented therefore their services are confidential. Anne shared some very touching stories about the progress made with some of the kids from the beginning of the school year to the end.
Anne Shankle Navos Mental Health and wellness. Child Youth, and Family Department	For students 13 years of age and older they also are able to provide medication if needed. Sessions are 3 times a week for 30-50 minutes. These are one on one sessions with an after school group session if the students want to talk with other classmates. They have 3 office locations, 2 in Burien and one in West Seattle.
New Business	Kim Cooper updated the Committee on Minor Home Repairs and Volunteer Chores that are being done in the community. Anela talked about the Career Fair that will be coming in the fall. Summer meals in the park information given along with Theater and Music in the Parks.
