
WHEREAS, on or around Nov. 1st, 2024 the Washington State Administrative Office of the Court (AOC) took all judicial information systems offline in order to contain and investigate a recent cyberattack;

WHEREAS AOC restored the systems necessary for the Court to function, the need to alter Court operations no longer exists.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. All court rules, policies, procedures, and statutes regarding filing, scheduling, docketing, and transmitting information are no longer suspended and shall return to the time frame established in state and local court rules.
2. The Court shall accept and process payments by check, money order or credit card for fines fees costs and assessments both on-line and at the clerk's windows. Cash will not be accepted.
3. All time requirements of CrRLJ 3.3, CrRLJ 4.1, CrRLJ 4.7, IRLJ 2.1, IRLJ 2.6 (both civil infractions and vehicle related violations) and any other court rule, policy, procedure, or statute governing 'time' shall no longer be suspended.
