CALL TO ORDER: The Arts, Culture & Library Advisory Committee meeting called to order at 5:33pm.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Minutes dated April 9, 2025, were approved unanimously.

LIBRARY REPORT: Valley View had a building update a month ago and they are now getting new furniture. Teen services librarian position is open. Program on July 8th – LEGO building program, had 24 attendees, also hosted an insect safari program, & adult watercolor session. The Library2Go van was at the Family Bike Rodeo, staff tabled at the Night Market at Angle Lake Park. Coming Up: Pixel art workshop with ReiRaz LLC, on Aug. 23rd, Intro to Hawaiian dancing, Sept. 10th 6:30-7:30pm, Back to School Resource Fair, featuring Eric Ode at Windsor heights. Over 400 people signed up for summer reading! Story Walk to go up in North SeaTac Park starting in September.

SIGN ARTWORK: Mason presented an update about signage going across the City for the next rollout, of all City gateway signs. This opportunity was an open call for all artists in WA state to apply for this project. The Committee was directed to review and select top 5 art submissions. Committee selected pieces, from 5 different artists.

RIVERTON SCULPTURE UPDATE: Nicole shared that the park is 60% complete on the design process. There were some concerns over the structures being attached to the plinth for anchoring and Nicole is in communication with the artists and architects to address concerns. Park is set to open in summer 2026.

SPECIAL EVENTS: Jessica shared information about events in the next 30 days and gave an overview of summer events to date.

OPEN FORUM:

- Roadhouse is doing very well, working with the City with grant support for events in Roadhouse. Second year celebration is coming soon.
- Pete will not continue with ACLAC for another term.
- Nicole has an RFP out for an artist to wrap the veteran's memorial generator. Art to be back by September's meeting for decision making.
